

Make a Banner Roundel

You will need:

- A paper plate
- Paint, colouring pens, chalk or crayons
- An old magazine or newspaper
- Scissors
- Glue stick
- Your imagination!

Let your imagination take you with this crafty activity. Paint a paper plate and cut out pieces from an old magazine or newspaper, stick on the wet paint to make a collage. This is perfect as a group or class activity too – why don't you put them together to make your own banner?





Make a Suffragette Rosette

You will need:

- Two strips of paper (a page from an old magazine is perfect)
- Two circles of card
- Sticky tape
- Colouring Pens



Instructions

Cut out a circle of card around 2cm in diameter – decorate one with colouring pens/ paint/ stickers, this will be the front of your badge.

Concertina the strips of paper then stretch into a rainbow shape.

Using sticky tape, join the two together to make a circle.

Make a roll of tape around your finger with the sticky side facing outwards, use that to stick the cardboard circles on the middle of each side.

Cut out two strips of paper and cut a V shape into one end of each

Stick these to the back of the badge

Stick a safety pin to the back

Wear your badge with pride.
